ESTATE: This estate of 18 hectares is located on the plateau Puisseguin (89m). Owned during more than one century by the Estager family, the property was taken over by Olivia and Didier Le Calvez in 2010, spurned on by their passion for wine and love for challenge.

SOILS: Clay-limestone

AGE OF THE VINES: 40 years

DENSITY: 6,500/ha

GRAPE VARIETIES: Merlot / Cabernet Sauvignon

WINEMAKING: Manual harvesting

AGING: 8 months in vats

TASTING NOTES: Blend of essentially Merlot with a deep garnet colour and violet reflections. The elegant and expressive nose reveals aromas of ripe fruit (blackberry, blackcurrant, raspberry) and slightly floral. The mouth is round with silky tannins and ends with a long and fruity finish.
