APPELLATION MÉDOC

Cru Bourgeois

Château Loirac is located in the northern part of the Médoc in Jau-Dignac et Loirac, which exists since the Roman times. During the 17th century, the Dutch dried out the swamps and the meadows, then used for the cattle, the production of cereals. On the top of the gravel hills. The estate produces generous wines.

Tasting notes :

This is an exceptional, concentrated and rich wine, with a deep garnet colour. The ageing in oak barrels brings notes of vanilla, some hints of grilled toasts, and also a rare aromatic complexity.

Soil : sandy gravels and poor soils

*Grape varieties : 40% Merlot,
60% Cabernet Sauvignon*

Average age of vines : 15 years old

*Vinegrowing and winemaking :
mechanical with several successive sorting-
out. The vinification is traditional, with cold
pre-fermentation (5-10 days)*

*Ageing : in oak barrels, (both origin French
and American oak, during 12-15 months).*
