25-30 years old

in stainless-steel vats

*Ageing :* in oak barrels  
during 12 months

**Tasting notes :**

*Château Pontey produces a wine with deep and generous colour, full-bodied and round, a charming wine! It matches perfectly with red meats, game and cheese.*

*Partly located on the hilltops of Médoc, Château Pontey, ranked Cru Bourgeois, is exposed on the southern hills of Blaignan. It usually produces 30-50000 bottles per year. Vines are part of the history of this small town, as we record mentions to vines back to the 14th century.*
