

MAISON BOUEY

CHÂTEAU SAINT CHRISTOLY

APPELLATION MÉDOC
Cru Bourgeois



Existing since end of 19th century, this château has been owned by the same family for years. Seven successive generations and traditional know-how are the motto of this Médoc cru bourgeois wine well known for its quality.

Tasting notes :

The colour is deep ruby with garnet tints, the nose is aromatic with notes of both blackberries and red berries, some vanilla touch. The mouth is full, the tannins are ripe and well-structured. Long on the finish.

Owner : Famille HERAUD

Vineyard : 29 ha

Located in the heart of Médoc, in Saint-Christoly du Médoc.

Soil : gravels from the Garonne with sand and clay

Grape varieties : 50% Merlot, 50% Cabernet Sauvignon

Average age of vines : 15 years old

Harvest : mechanical with integrated sorting-out and stemmer de-pipper on the machine.

Ageing : 12 months in oak barrels
