

# CHÂTEAU SAINT-YZANS

## MÉDOC

Château Saint-Yzans is named after the village of Saint Yzans de Médoc, where it is located.

Its incredible terroir offers a large and rich range of harmonious nuances. Maison Bouey has been writing a new chapter in its story since 2015.

*Area:* 5 hectares

*Location:* Saint-Yzans-de-Médoc

*Terroir:* Clay-limestone

*Average age of the vines:* 25 years

*Grape Varieties:* 60% Merlot, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon

*Aging:* 12 months

### *Tasting notes:*

Château Saint-Yzans 2012 unveils an intense ruby color and a nose of red fruits, such as cherry, and soft spices. The palate delivers ripe tannins, which gives roundness to the wine. A nice freshness brings length. This wine, which is still evolving, already presents a nice harmony.
