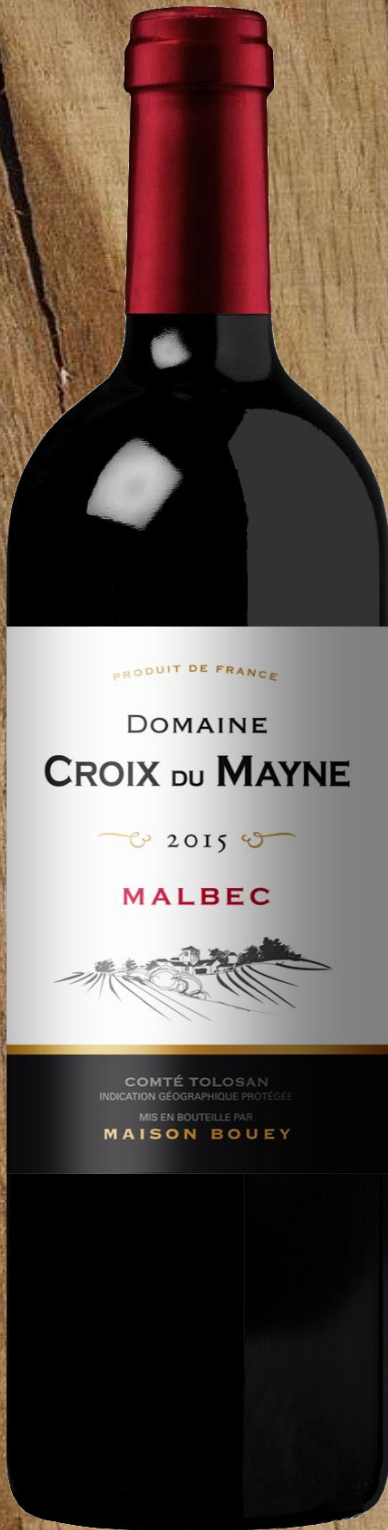


DOMAINE CROIX DU MAYNE

IGP COMTÉ TOLOSAN



THE ESTATE: Domaine Croix du Mayne is located in Anglars-Juillac, in the Lot valley, 30km West from Cahors. Since the 15th century, the Pélissié family has maintained the tradition in this area.

After « Sieur » Pélissié at the beginning of the 19th century, Antoine Pélissié at the end of the 19th century, and Alban and Jean-Pierre Pélissié at the beginning of the 20th century, François Pélissié has taken over the family estate in 1987 and developed it from 4 to 20 hectares in less than 10 years with the acquisition of new plots, chosen for their soil quality and their exposure. Domaine Croix du Mayne covers today 35 hectares.



SOIL: The estate covers 35 hectares, with gravelly soils in the 2nd terrace of the Lot valley, also called « moyenne terrasse du Riss », created 200,000 years ago. The vineyard enjoys a South and South-West exposure, that is ideal for the grapes maturity.

GRAPE: Malbec

A powerful and vigorous varietal, the Malbec gets its best expression and outstanding character from the sunny lands and terroirs of its native Southwestern France vineyards. The average age of the vines is 20 years old.

TASTING NOTES: Domaine Croix du Mayne reveals a beautiful balance between fruity and delicate aromas combined with silky and delicate tannins. The palate opens with intensity. The finish is discreetly oaky.



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
