THE ESTATE: Château Le Plantou was acquired by the Nelly family in 1993. It is located in the Perigord Pourpre area, along the Dordogne river, 5km from a XIIIth-century church which has been built to defend against the English.

In the heart of the Dropt valley, the terroir of Bergerac reveals a rich historic heritage and a mosaic of soils where different grape varieties express their best to create elegant and powerful wines.



SOIL: 25-hectare vineyard in red / 8-hectare vineyard in white. Clay-limestone soil

AVERAGE AGE OF THE VINES: 20 years

DENSITY: 3 300 à 4 000 feet/ha

GRAPE VARIETIES: 44% Merlot, 20% Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Sémillon, 1% Muscadelle

BLEND: 50% Cabernet Franc, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot

TASTING NOTES: This wine reveals an intense garnet red color and a complex ripe red fruit nose. The palate is round and structured with a good aromatic intensity. Long and expressive on the finish.

Serve at room temperature.

Perfect to accompany white meats, duck confits or sheep's cheese.
