Carefully selected by Patrick Bouey, owner of Château Lestruelle, with Nicolas Meylan, Estate Manager, this wine has been created with the same careful finesse and requirement that apply to all other cuvees and estates for the Bouey Family Vineyards and Châteaux, a signature that is of the highest quality and excellence.

TERROIR: Clay-limestone and gravel soils in the village of Soullignac, 35km south-east of Bordeaux

GRAPE VARIETIES: 70% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc

WINEMAKING: Mechanical harvest. Alcoholic fermentation in thermo-controlled stainless steel vats. Aging in vats.

TASTING NOTES: Lestruelle Bordeaux Red 2014 presents a nice garnet red color with purple hints. The nose reveals ripe red fruits aromas such as strawberry and morello cherry. The rich and fleshy palate makes this wine especially charming and pleasant.
