

LES PARCELLES

de Stéphane Derenoncourt

BORDEAUX BLANC

SOIL : Clayey and limestone soils from 4 plots specifically selected in the « Pellegrue » sector, near the commune of Landerrouat in the heart of the Entre-DeuxMers Region, between the Garonne and Dordogne Rivers, 45km East of Bordeaux, South East of Saint-Emilion. These plots are mid way between the Dordogne river in the North and the Garonne in the South.

GRAPE VARIETIES : 95 % sauvignon, 5% sémillon

WINEMAKING : Each of the four parcels is harvested and vinified separately at the Landerrouat winery. Slow pressing and temperature controlled fermentation in stainless steel vats.

AGEING : Best enjoyed in its young age to enjoy its freshness and character

TASTING NOTES : Beautiful gold color supported by bright and cristal clear greeny hints. Delicate citrus and grapefruit dominated nose, with white peach in the background. Ample palate, well structured with a firm citrus notes attack. The whole is well-melted and harmonious. Beautiful lenght, lively finish.
