THE ESTATE

Château Haut-Boilon is located on the commune of Saint-Caprais-de-Blaye, a village 60 km northeast of Bordeaux. In the Penaud family for 5 generations the property is in constant evolution and is currently conducting an bio agriculture conversion.

In 1978 Patrick Penaud undertaking major changes throughout the property by restructuring the entire vineyard.

Concerned about the impact of its activities on the environment, he decided to drive his vineyard farming.

SOIL & WINEMAKING

Area : 57 acres

Soil: clay and sandy / gravelly - siliceous

Grape varieties: 85% Merlot - 10% Cabernet Sauvignon - Malbec 5%

Average age of the vines: 20 years

Winemaking: A maceration is performed to extract maximum color and favor fresh fruit flavors and traditional maceration 2 to 4 weeks in temperature-controlled concrete vats.

TASTING NOTES

Beautiful red ruby color, intense and clear. The nose is fresh and spicy, with flavors of black cherry and blackberry. A pleasant and supple attack, with smooth and round tannins. A nice finish on the fruit, with lovely notes of blackcurrant. A nice balance for this rich and delicate wine.
