## CASTILLON CÔTES DE BORDEAUX

**ESTATE:** Château TOUR DE FILLOL has been a family estate since 1958, taken over in 2001 by Francis Pallaro. The vineyard now covers nearly 14.5 ha on the hills of Sainte-Colombe. Cuvée Horizon for a wine that sees far away. Planted on a clay-limestone soil, overlooking the plain, the vines benefit from a north-south exposure and a full sunshine producing fruity wines with a red, supple and round fruit color.

**SOIL:** Clay-limestone

**GRAPE VARIETIES:** 88% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Franc

**WINEMAKING:** Traditional winemaking with control of temperatures.

### TASTING NOTES:

With a rather dense purplish red color, the nose offers a nice complexity between black cherry notes and spicy aromas. The palate has a very nice balance. The present tannins are soft and sweet. We find the aromas of the nose on a beautiful aromatic persistence.
